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#### LOCATION:

The King's Ranch, 17151 Baugh Street NW, Ramsey MN (directions page 8). Be aware our field is in a residential neighborhood.

Field is well-maintained grass, completely fenced on all sides, and bordered with evergreen trees. Large gravel parking lot with limited RV space adjacent to the field, but without shade. Climate-controlled pole barn also adjacent to the field, conrcete floor, available for crating. Water and restrooms on-site.

Minnesota fall weather is typically upper 40s at night, 50s-60s during the day; be prepared.

#### **ENTRY FEES:**

- \$30 first dog and \$25 each additional dog for early entries.
- \$35 per dog after September I.

For dogs entering this event as a First Time Entry (FTE) there is an additional \$2 LGRA / \$2 NOTRA registration fee that must be submitted with your entry. All dogs must be qualified to run prior to the start of the respective meet (see page 4).

If at roll call, your dog is lame or in season, your entry fees will be refunded. However, as costs are incurred and budgets set, if you're able to donate your fees to help defer the event costs, it would be appreciated. There will be no substitutions for lame or in-season hounds.

See page 15 for how to submit entries & fees and page 20-21 for entry forms.

#### **CLOSING DATES:**

No entries allowed on the day of the meets. No refund of entries after September 20, except for lame or in-season hounds at inspection.

Early entries close <u>September 1</u>. Final entry deadline September 15.

#### **RACE MEETS:**

LGRA Race Meet will be 3 programs, 4-dog races, 200-yard drag lure. NOTRA Race Meet will be 3 programs, 4-dog races, 300-yard drag lure.

All breeds boxed except Borzoi, Irish Wolfhounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, and Scottish Deerhounds. Starting Box consists of 4 boxes; dimensions – length: 46", width: 14", height: 35"; distance between boxes: 7"; width of doors: 16"; overall dimensions: 84"x46".

#### **ELIGIBLE BREEDS:**

LGRA: Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Medio/Grande, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, and Sloughis.

NOTRA: Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, and Sloughis.

#### **ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE:**

All hounds must be I year of age, or older, on the day of the race meet; not lame, sick, or in season. Each hound must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC), Canadian Kennel Club (CKC), United Kennel Club (UKC), or with the National Greyhound Association (NGA). Hounds registered with the AKC under Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) or Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or the CKC equivalent may also be entered.

#### FIRST TIME ENTRY (FTE) & DOGS WITH 3 INCOMPLETE MEETS:

Any FTE dog as well as any dog that has ONLY incomplete meets for its last 3 meets will be required to have a qualification run prior to the Nationals; include proof of qualification with your entry. Hounds cannot race unless qualified. We strongly recommend you get your dog certified in advance of the Nationals at another meet; although we will offer LGRA-only qualification runs on Friday, by reservation only (see page 19).

Definition of FTE and Incomplete Meets

- FTE: A dog that is being entered in competition for the first time.
- LGRA 3 Incomplete Meets: The Grading Guide shows a "y" next to the score of last 3 meets.
- NOTRA 3 Incomplete Meets: The Grading Guide shows that all of the last 3 meets had an off course (oc), did not finish (dnf), or incomplete (y) designation next to the date of meet.

**Proof** of qualification shall include:

- Statement with the name and signature of the Race Secretary who certified the dog.
- The name of the club that the Race Secretary represents.
- The date of the qualification run.
- A statement that the dog came out of the racing box (breeds listed on page 3 as exempt from box-starts at 2023 Nationals may be hand-slipped) and ran the entire track cleanly with another dog of the same breed or with a similar racing style.

**Note:** A dog that is an FTE in NOTRA, but has competed successfully in LGRA, must STILL provide proof of qualification in NOTRA before allowed to compete in NOTRA; however, a dog that is an FTE in LGRA and has competed successfully in NOTRA (can show a complete meet in the NOTRA grading guide) is qualified for LGRA.

**Note:** FTE dogs must also apply for a racing number (see: <u>LGRA number application \_0.pdf</u>; <u>NRN-application.pdf (notraracing.org)</u>). You may submit the appropriate racing-number application (with a copy of breed registration) with your Nationals entry.

#### **VETERANS:**

A rosette will be awarded to the high-scoring veteran in each breed.

Eligibility is as follows:

- Your hound MUST complete all 3 programs and
- Hound must be 7 years of age or older for LGRA and 5 years or older for NOTRA, on the day
  of the meet.

#### **ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION:**

Saturday & Sunday: 7:30 am sharp; please be on time.

NOTE: Racers that are <u>not present at roll call</u> will be marked absent and are NOT eligible for refund. Racers will be inspected for lameness, sickness, being in-season, and correct fit of racing muzzle.

#### **CRATING:**

Crating is available in the climate-controlled pole barn. Crating in vehicles is also possible but note that there is no shade in the parking area.

#### **PARKING:**

Parking (gravel lot) is available adjacent to the pole barn and race field.

#### **VOLUNTEERS:**

As always, race meets can't be run without great volunteers. We need everyone to help! We encourage you to volunteer for any job in which you are able to help,— line judging, foul judging, or assisting owners with boxing or catching dogs. Volunteer schedules will be posted on the morning of each event, and arranged to allow you time to run and care for your own dogs. Sign-up form on page 19.


#### DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD AT THE KING'S RANCH:

NOTE: There is major road construction in the Anoka area; please follow posted detours, which may deviate from the following directions.

FROM THE SOUTH – US 169 to US 10W in Anoka. LEFT/WEST on 10 approx. 4.5 mi to Armstrong Blvd/Co 83. RIGHT on Armstrong approx. 4.3 mi to 173<sup>rd</sup> Ave NW. LEFT on 173<sup>rd</sup> and immediate LEFT on Baugh St NW. The King's Ranch is on the left; use the 2<sup>nd</sup> driveway.

FROM THE EAST – I-694 to US 10W to Anoka; proceed as above.

FROM THE NORTHWEST – US 10 SOUTH to Armstrong Blvd/Co 83. LEFT on Armstrong approx. 4.3 mi to 173<sup>rd</sup> Ave NW. LEFT on 173<sup>rd</sup> and immediate LEFT on Baugh St NW. The King's Ranch is on the left; use the 2<sup>rd</sup> driveway.
